Adoption Requirements and Procedure

Thank you for considering giving a permanent loving home to a rescued llama!

Adoptive homes must provide:

- a minimum of ½ acre exercise space for 2 llamas
- a safe, well maintained fence- 5 ft stable mesh (no barbed wire)
- shelter from inclement weather
- hay and Llama Supplement
- mineral salt
- routine care including vaccinations, deworming, shearing and toenail trimming
- veterinary care as needed

SWLR adoption fee is \$250.00

SWLR does not place solitary llamas.

SWLR is committed to the lifelong care of every llama that passes through our gates. Adoptive homes must return llamas that they no longer want or cannot care for, to SWLR and must permit periodic inspection of the animals and facilities by a mentor or peer SWLR reviewer. If new to llamas, the adopter must find a mentor who will teach them how to shear, trim toenails, give injections, de-worm and help out with emergencies.

SWLR is committed to the prevention of overpopulation of llamas. All females and males are placed with a non-breeding contract.
